

BROADER PUBLIC SECTOR ACCOUNTABILITY ACT

CGMH has been operating under a comprehensive travel and expense policy for many years.

Recently, the Provincial Government mandated as part of the Broader Public Sector Accountability Act (BPSAA) new requirements for travel and expense policies as well as new requirements for reporting of expenses to the public. These directives were clarified for hospitals by the Government on March 30, 2011.

As a result of the recent clarification, CGMH is now in the process of reviewing its existing policy (see draft below) and updating it, where necessary, to ensure it meets the criteria set out in these new directives. Once the review is complete, we will post the finalized policy on this page no later than April 30, 2011.

The BPSSA also lays out requirements for public reporting of a number of other policies and detailed information. All of this information will be posted, according to the Government schedule on this page in the future.
