The Collingwood G&M Hospital is excited to announce the arrival of two new specialists to care for area residents and visitors.

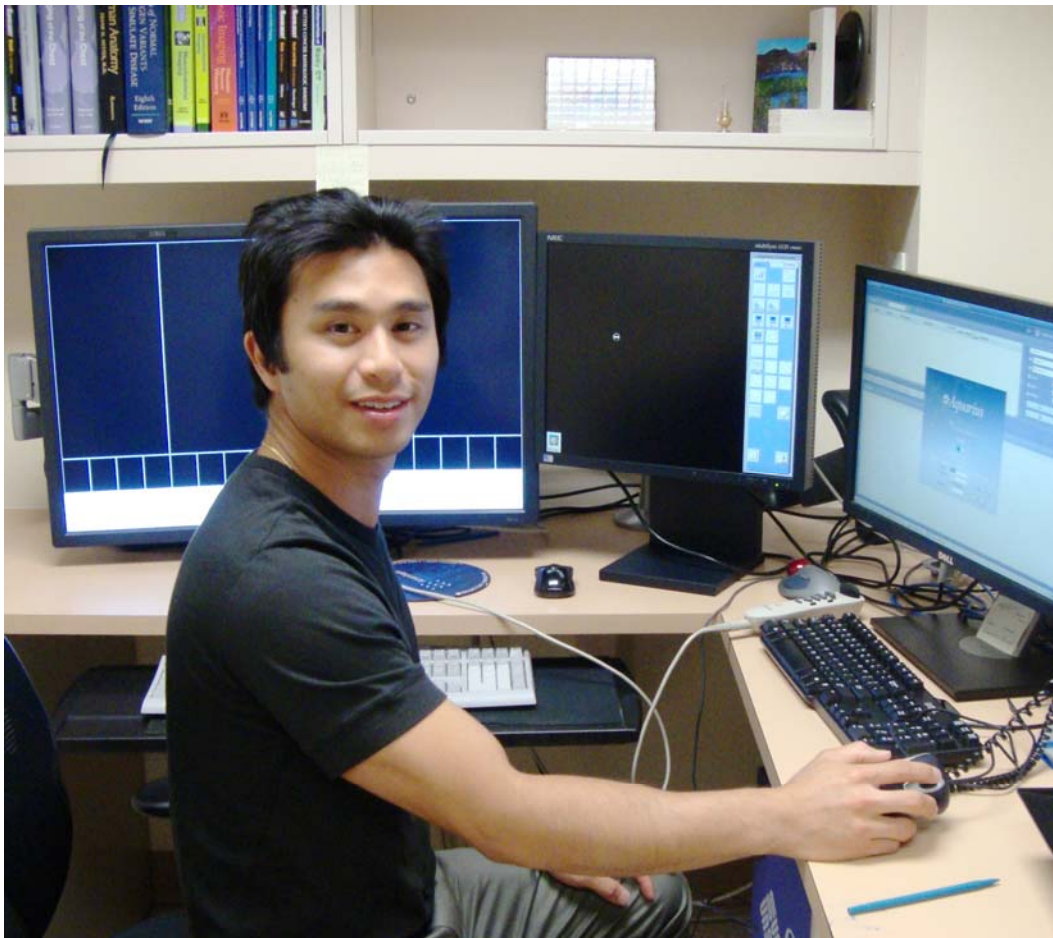
